## CHRIST, OUR EXAMPLE IN OBEDIENCE

While Christ is our example in all things and we must walk in his footsteps (1 Pet. 2:21), in this article I want to concentrate on one aspect of his life as found in Matt. 6:38 - "For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me".

When we examine this passage, we note two things which show us how we must be as Christians. First, Jesus did not come down to do his own will. Although a part of the Godhead, Jesus took on the form of man to walk among us and give us the guidance we need to make it to Heaven (Phil. 2:5ff). He humbled himself and did not exalt himself, but glorified God. He shows us what it means to be a servant of God. We must first remove ourselves from the picture. We are not here to serve our wants, but to yield ourselves to God.

Second, he came to do the will of the one that sent him. He shows us that we are to obey God. Jesus stated in Matt. 4:10 that we are to worship and serve only God. Jesus was obedient even to the death on the cross (Phil. 2:8). In the garden prior to his arrest and crucifixion, Jesus prayed that God's will be done and not his (Lk. 22:42). Even that which was spoken by Jesus was that which the father had given to him (Jn. 12:48-50). Truly, Jesus is the master example of obedience.

As we think about our lives, are we following the example Jesus gave to us? When we live each day of our lives, who are we obeying? There is never a time we are not obeying someone, whether it be God or the Devil. For you and I to one day dwell eternally with God, we must follow Jesus - "Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ" (1 Cor. 11:1).
