HUMAN RIGHTS

I was asked not long ago to comment on human rights, and as I gave my answer, it amazed me how many passages in the Bible came to mind to show the respect for the dignity of each human being. We live in a world where there have been and continue to be those who misuse or abuse other people. Man does not have the answer to treating one another with respect, dignity, kindness, and fairness. The world does not have the answer to looking to the best of ALL people. While the

world does not have the answer to this, God does. This is one of the reasons why it is so important to spread the gospel throughout the world and convert souls to Christ. Think about some of the things the Bible teaches that, if followed, would end human right's abuses. These would also end individuals mistreating one another.

1. Matt. 7:12 – Do to others what you want done to you. No one wants to be mistreated. Everyone wants to be respected. Why then would we mistreat one another or fail to show the proper respect for one another?
2. Acts 10:34 – With God, there is no respect of persons. Couple this with Jas. 2:9 where if we have respect of persons we do sin and Matt. 5:48 where we are taught to be perfect as God is perfect, and we can understand that if we show respect of persons (prejudice) we will be lost eternally.
3. Gal. 6:10 – In this passage, we are taught to do good to all men. This would eliminate anything that does not seek the best for others.
4. Matt. 25:31-46 – Here in this scene of Judgment, we find that those who were rewarded were those who helped those who were in need.
5. Jas. 1:27 – Our work is to visit the fatherless and the widows. In truth, we are to come to the aid of these individuals.
6. Mark 16:15 – The commission given by Jesus is to seek to save all men – ALL MEN!. Rather than doing evil to others, we must seek to help those around us make it to Heaven.

We must treat others with respect, dignity, kindness, and fairness because this is how God treats people. This is what helps us individually and as nations. We must remember that God created of one blood all nations (Acts 17:26).
