## Jesus Wept

*“And said, Where have ye laid him? They said unto him, Lord, come and see. Jesus wept. Then said the Jews, Behold how he loved him!”* (John 11:34-36).

In the midst of this passage, is one of the most powerful verses in the Bible – Jesus wept. It conveys to us the care and compassion Jesus had for people. It lets us know that Jesus still cares for his people.

Jesus had traveled to the home of Mary and Martha because of the illness and finally the death of Lazarus, their brother. When Jesus came to the area he asked to see the tomb of Lazarus, and it is here that he wept.

The Jews, who watched Jesus, could not help but notice how much he loved Lazarus. The loss of this man hurt Jesus.

Luke records a second time when Jesus wept. In Luke 19:41, Jesus looks over the city of Jerusalem and weeps because they had rejected God and Jerusalem was to be destroyed. It hurt Jesus that these would be lost.

The compassion of Jesus is seen throughout his life, and he has promised to be with us even to the end of the ages (Matthew 28:20). When we think things are bad, we need to remember that Jesus cares.

Jesus has told us that if we come unto him, he will give us rest. As Christians, we have this great comfort.
